What is a Screening?

Screening is used to identify those who may need an assessment. It does not determine the presence or absence of a communication disorder. A screening gives a 'pass' or 'refer' result. They are helpful when guardians are wondering *whether it is worthwhile to arrange a full assessment*.

Assessment is done to diagnose or rule out communication disorders. An assessment provides a profile of communication strengths and difficulties and prognosis for improvement with treatment. If treatment is recommended, an assessment informs treatment planning and recommendations.

If your child receives a 'refer' result, we will give you information about how to access speech-language pathology and/or audiology services in the public and/or private sector.
